Fill out all the information on the next screen and press the "Send Form" button at the bottom on the right. **DO NOT CLICK** the "Clear Form" button.

After completing the above steps, you will be brought to the screen to enter the IP addresses for your institution. These IP addresses should conform to the Terms and Conditions of your license. Read the "Help with IP Addresses" to see how to enter IP ranges.
