## Nine Items Assessing Mental Health Literacy on Mental Health First Aid Post-Test Feedback Form

Participants are asked to indicate, as a result of the mental health first aid training, the extent to which they feel more confident that they can:

- 1. Recognize the signs that someone may be dealing with a mental health (MH) problem or crisis
- 2. Reach out to someone who may be dealing with a MH problem or crisis.
- 3. Ask a person whether s/he is considering killing her/himself.
- 4. Actively and compassionately listen to someone in distress.
- 5. Offer a distressed person basic "first aid" level information and reassurance about MH problems.
- 6. Assist a person who may be dealing with a MH problem or crisis to seek professional help.
- 7. Assist a person who may be dealing with a MH problem/crisis to connect with community, peer, and personal supports
- 8. Be aware of my own views and feelings about MH problems and disorders
- 9. Recognize and correct misconceptions about MH and mental illness as I encounter them.
