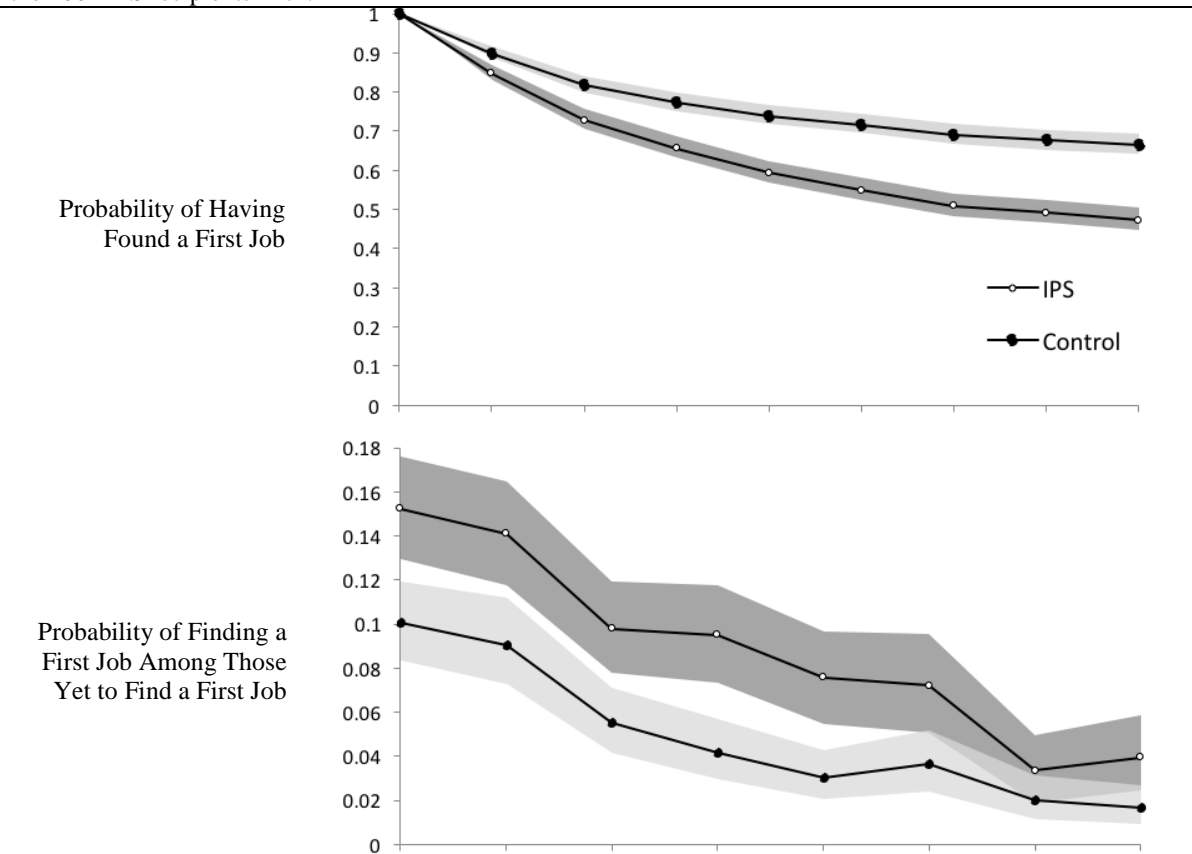


Standardized Discharge in IPS Supported Employment

Results of Kaplan-Meier analysis of time to first job comparing recipients of IPS and control conditions over two years of follow-up. Bands indicate 95% confidence limits. Table summarizes results as observed among the 1004 IPS recipients in the Mental Health Treatment Study
