Tests of significance included one-way ANOVA and Pearson correlations for categorical and continuous variables, respectively. Analyses were two-tailed. Continuous measures included the following: PHQ-9= Patient Health Questionnaire (range= 0-27, higher scores indicate greater symptomatology); PCL= Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD) Patient Checklist (range=17-85, higher scores indicate greater symptomatology); SF-12 = Short Form Health Survey of the Medical Outcomes Study (range=0-100, higher scores indicate greater mental/physical functioning); Binges in prior 3 months (range=0-150); Average number of alcoholic drinks in past week (range=0=29). WLQ Subscale range (0-100) with the exception of Productivity Loss Subscale (range=0-25) and Productivity Cost (range=0-8116).
